Industrial Action arrangements

The school has received notification from the NEU trade union that its members propose to take industrial action on Wednesday 1st. This action relates to a national dispute over school funding and teachers pay and conditions.

I have completed a risk assessment and propose to open the school only to the classes not directly affected by the strike action.

A further assessment will be undertaken on the morning of the strike action, and I may need to review my decision, however, in the unlikely event that the school will need to be closed to pupils, I will of course ensure that you are contacted as soon as possible. Please be aware this may be on the day of the strike.

Please ensure the school has your current contact details.

Any child absent due to the strike will not have their attendance record affected.

Any dinner monies paid for this date will be credited to the pupil's account.

Children entitled to free school meals:

School will provide a packed lunch for those children who are unable to attend school on 1st February because of industrial action who receive a free school meal. This will be a sandwich and a yoghurt/biscuit. It will be available for collection from the school office from 11a.m.

Please return the slip tomorrow so that the kitchen staff can make arrangements and order necessary items.
