Just a reminder that school day starts at **8.50** am and finishes at **3.20** pm.

Nursery morning session: **8.50 am – 11.50 am.**Nursery afternoon session: **12.20 am – 3.20 pm.**

The gates are opened at 8.40 to allow children to get to their classrooms.

It is very important that children arrive at school for the start of the day. Learning is planned in class from 8.50 and if your child is late they will miss this learning time. It is also uncomfortable for children to come in late and this can affect their confidence at the start of their day.

School Lunch

If your child brings a packed lunch, it must not contain any hot food, for example, soup in a flask, chicken nuggets, rice etc. Packed lunches can contain cold wraps such as sandwiches, wraps, fruit, cake, yoghurt, veg sticks etc. No fizzy drinks or glass bottles are allowed. Water is provided on the tables, or your child may have a soft drink or water in their lunch bag.
