Uniform edition

We believe school uniform plays a key role in **promoting pride**, **self-confidence**, **and a feeling of belonging**. These factors contribute to our pupil's wellbeing and removes any pressures of deciding what to wear and asking parents for expensive fashion items for school wear.

We encourage pupils to feel proud to be part of our school family and this includes the wearing of correct uniform. We are also mindful of the majority of our families culture and traditions, whilst being part of a community school in Oldham.

We introduced the use of white, long or short sleeved shirts in Year 6 so that children would look smart wearing the school tie and could leave their sweatshirts etc at home on hot days and still feel 'covered' if they wished.

We have noticed that parents are often choosing to send their children in black leggings to school and so we have introduced these into our uniform.

During Covid we stopped changing for PE in school and children came dressed in their PE uniform. We will continue with this as many of our families prefer for their child not to get changed at school. However the PE uniform is not worn by all children and we are addressing this for September. We have introduced branded polo shirts in house colours and a purple branded zip-up hoody.

We are mindful of costs and although we have introduced branded PE t-shirts and a hoody I am assuring you that a polo shirt in your child's house colour is acceptable and your child can wear their school sweatshirt or cardigan over their polo shirt.

We are also asking that if a child wears a head scarf they are the pull on kind for health and safety reasons and no pins are allowed.

If you have any concerns with the cost of uniform, please come and speak to a member of office staff or speak to one of the leadership team who are available every day, at the school gates, before and after school.

All our uniform is available at Debonaire in Oldham and non-branded items are stocked at Asda, Tesco and all main supermarkets.



Our School Uniform



Purple sweatshirt or cardigan and a white polo shirt.

Grey skirt, trousers or pinafore and/or black leggings.



Year 6 children can wear a white short or long sleeved shirt and a school tie. They can also wear a leaver's hoody if they wish.





On hot days children should leave their sweatshirts etc. at home. They can also wear shorts or a summer dress in purple or yellow check if you wish.





A pull on plain head scarf in purple, black or white. Sensible, non-slip shoes or trainers, preferably black.

Our indoor PE uniform



Polo shirts in your child's house colour with black leggings, black jogging bottoms or black shorts.





Black pumps with brown soles for indoor PE. These should be named and kept in school in a drawstring bag on your child's peg.

Our outdoor PE uniform

Polo shirts in your child's house colour with black leggings, black jogging bottoms or black shorts (as above) and trainers.

A purple zip-up hoody (with logo available) or a school branded sweatshirt or cardigan.
