## Important Words -

**transport** – moving people or things from one place to another.

**vehicle** – something that moves people and things e.g. car.

**country** — an area of land with its own rules and leaders. E.g. England is a country.

**abroad** – going outside the United Kingdom

**jog** – running at a slow pace.

**environmentally friendly** – living in a way which doesn't impact the area where we live in.

**journey** – a long trip from one place to another place.

# Different ways to travel

People can also travel on foot by walking, jogging or running.





Travelling on foot (e.g. walking) or by bicycle is the most **environmentally friendly** way to travel.



People will need to use other kinds of transport to travel longer distances to places that are far away. This might be on a plane, train or boat.

In London, many people travel using the **London Underground** which is also known as "The **Tube"**.





# Travel in Bangladesh
