## Our Local Area

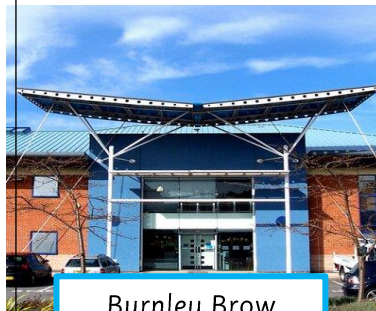
- We live in Chadderton.

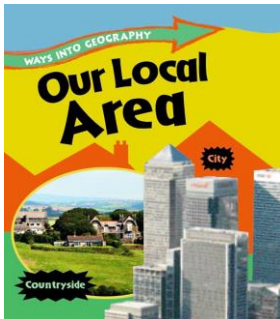

A bungalow is a house with only one floor.

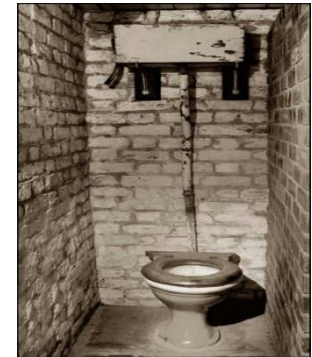


A semi-detached house is joined to one other house.
